<b>CATFISH</b>	Horseshoe Cove, Geezer Cove, T-Dock, Bass Cove
<b>TROUT</b>	Horseshoe cove, Paradise Cove, Pumphouse Cove
<b>BASS</b>	Paradise Cove, Geezer Cove
<b>PANFISH/CARP</b>	Shallows, Geezer Gove (Panfish) + Geezer Cove or T-Dock (Carp)

## BEST LURES/BAITS

<b>CATFISH</b>	Mackerel, Bonito, Night crawlers
<b>TROUT</b>	Powerbait, Night crawlers
<b>BASS</b>	Swimbait, Plastics
<b>PANFISH/CARP</b>	Mealworms (Panfish) + dough balls, corn (Carp)

## CATCH HIGHLIGHTS

<b>CATFISH</b>	Catfish has really picked up. A few 2-4lb were caught using Mackerel in Geezer Cove.
<b>TROUT</b>	Trout is in full swing. Anglers are getting full stringers. John Miller from La Mesa had a 9lb stringer with the biggest at 2 lbs. Jaylin Iqlesias had an 11.4lb stringer with the biggest at 3lb
<b>BASS</b>	Bass bite has been slow. Paul Kolinek from Pine Valley caught a 9.9lber.
<b>PANFISH/CARP</b>	No reports of any Crappie, Bluegill or Redear Sunfish are being caught. Carp are being caught all over the lake.
