## GENERAL INFORMATION

Lake Morena County Park is located at 2550 Lake Morena Drive, Campo, CA 91906.

The lake is open 5:30 a.m. to 7:30pm.

- The current water temperature is 78 degrees.
- No live bait fish or crayfish.
- **State fishing license is required.**

## NEWS AND EVENTS

- The Lower Boat Launch is still currently open. All vessels must pass a Quagga Inspection (clean, drained, and dry) prior to launch.

## BEST SPOTS

<b>CATFISH</b>	Geezer Cove, T-Dock, North of Pumphouse Cove
<b>TROUT</b>	Horseshoe cove, Paradise Cove, Pumphouse Cove
<b>BASS</b>	Paradise Cove, Geezer Cove, North shoreline
<b>PANFISH/CARP</b>	Horseshoe Cove, Geezer Gove (Panfish) + Geezer Cove or T-Dock (Carp)

## BEST LURES/BAITS

<b>CATFISH</b>	Mackerel, Bonito, chicken liver, Night crawlers
<b>TROUT</b>	Powerbait, Night crawlers, Mini Jigs, Kastmasters
<b>BASS</b>	Swimbait, Plastics, crankbaits, jigs
<b>PANFISH/CARP</b>	Mealworms & night crawlers (Panfish) + dough balls, corn (Carp)

## CATCH HIGHLIGHTS

<b>CATFISH</b>	Catfish are being caught all over the lake around trees and rocks using chicken liver and mackerel.
<b>TROUT</b>	Trout season has ended for the most part.
<b>BASS</b>	There is still a decent early morning and afternoon bite for the bass mostly on plastics or topwater.
<b>PANFISH/CARP</b>	The carp are all over seen jumping in schools or up tight to the shoreline. Panfish are still being caught on crappie jigs and meal worms up tight to the shoreline in the rocks.
