# FISH REPORT

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Lake Morena County Park is located at 2550 Lake Morena Drive, Campo, CA 91906.

The lake is open 5:30 a.m. to 6:30pm.

- The current water temperature is 77 degrees.
- No live bait fish or crayfish.
- **State fishing license is required.**

## NEWS AND EVENTS

- The Lower Boat Launch is open. All vessels must pass a Quagga Inspection (clean, drained, and dry) prior to launch.

<b>CATFISH</b>	Horseshoe Cove, Geezer Cove, T-Dock, Bass Cove
<b>TROUT</b>	<b>Not in Season</b>
<b>BASS</b>	Paradise Cove, Geezer Cove
<b>PANFISH/CARP</b>	Shallows (Panfish) + Geezer Cove or T-Dock (Carp)

## BEST LURES/BAITS

<b>CATFISH</b>	Mackerel, Bonito, Nightcrawlers
<b>TROUT</b>	<b>Not in Season</b>
<b>BASS</b>	Swimbait, Plastics
<b>PANFISH/CARP</b>	Mealworms (Panfish) + dough balls, corn (Carp)

## CATCH HIGHLIGHTS

<b>CATFISH</b>	Catfish has really picked up. A few 2-4lb's were caught using Mackerel in Horseshoe cove. Most anglers are catching 1-2lb cats.
<b>TROUT</b>	Trout Bite has ended.
<b>BASS</b>	Bass bite has really slowed down. Only one 9lb reported this week
<b>PANFISH/CARP</b>	No reports of any Crappie, Bluegill or Sunfish being taken this week. Carp are being caught all over the lake. Ayden Vue from San Diego caught 10 carp with the biggest weighing in at 9lbs
