FISH REPORT

GENERAL INFORMATION

Lake Morena County Park is located at 2550 Lake Morena Drive, Campo, CA 91906.

The lake is open 5:30 a.m. to 6:30pm.

- The current water temperature is 74 degrees.
- No live bait fish or crayfish.
- **State fishing license is required.**

NEWS AND EVENTS

- The Lower Boat Launch is open. All vessels must pass a Quagga Inspection (clean, drained, and dry) prior to launch.

BEST SPOTS

CATFISH	Horseshoe Cove, Geezer Cove, T-Dock, Bass Cove
TROUT	Not in Season
BASS	Paradise Cove, Geezer Cove
PANFISH/CARP	Shallows, Geezer Gove (Panfish) + Geezer Cove or T-Dock (Carp)

BEST LURES/BAITS

CATFISH	Mackerel, Bonito, Night crawlers
TROUT	Not in Season
BASS	Swimbait, Plastics
PANFISH/CARP	Mealworms (Panfish) + dough balls, corn (Carp)

CATCH HIGHLIGHTS

CATFISH	Catfish has really picked up. A few 2-4lb were caught using Mackerel in Geezer Cove. A 10-12lb was caught using mackerel in Horseshoe cove.
TROUT	Not in Season
BASS	Bass bite has really slowed down. Only one 6lber reported this week
PANFISH/CARP	No reports of any Crappie being taken but Bluegill and Redear Sunfish are being caught in bunches. Anglers are using mealworms from the shoreline and all catches are less than a 1lb. Carp are being caught all over the lake.
