GENERAL INFORMATION

Lake Morena County Park is located at 2550 Lake Morena Drive, Campo, CA 91906. The lake is open 5:30a.m. to 7:30pm.

- The current surface water temperature is 62 degrees.
- No live bait fish or crayfish.
- **CA STATE FISHING LICENSE IS REQUIRED!**

NEWS AND EVENTS

- As a result of the 2019 winter rainfall totals, Lake Morena's water level is up approximately 11 vertical feet! Cottonwood Creek is still flowing into the lake.
- **The Lower Boat Launch is OPEN!** An \$8 launch fee is required for all vessels.
- All vessels must pass a Quagga Mussel inspection (Clean, Drained, & Dry).
- Last Trout stock of the season took place March 19th.

BEST SPOTS

CATFISH	Geezer Cove, T-Dock, North of Pumphouse Cove
TROUT	Horseshoe cove, Paradise Cove, Pumphouse Cove
BASS	Paradise Cove, Geezer Cove, North shoreline
PANFISH/CARP	Horseshoe Cove, Geezer Gove (Panfish) + Geezer Cove or T-Dock (Carp)

BEST LURES/BAITS

CATFISH	Mackerel, Bonito, Chicken Liver, Night Crawlers
TROUT	Powerbait, Night crawlers, Mini Jigs, Kastmasters
BASS	Swimbait, Plastics, Crankbaits, Jigs
PANFISH/CARP	Meal worms & Night Crawlers (Pan fish) + Dough Balls, Corn (Carp)

CATCH HIGHLIGHTS

CATFISH	Cut mackerel and chicken liver in the submerged trees have been producing good amounts of catfish.
TROUT	Several limits of trout are being caught everyday from boats and the shoreline with a variety of baits including power bait, night crawlers, Thomas Buoyants, Rapalas and Kastmasters.
PANFISH/CARP	Crappie are being caught off the shoreline near the rock out croppings in Horseshoe Cove.
BASS	The bass are moving up into shallower water. Plastics, jigs and swim baits should be the key right now.
