



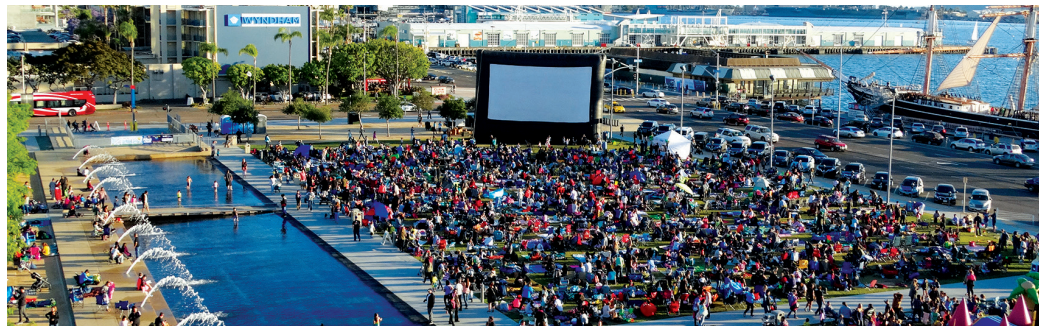

July 1, 6 p.m. | Summer Movie in the Park: Free Guy (PG-13)

Beginning at 6 p.m., park staff will be set up on the civic green lawns for a movie pre-party featuring games and activities, arts and crafts, resource booths, dancing, food trucks and more. Come early, and to secure your "seat" with blankets, chairs and your favorite picnic items.

Enjoy the fire show in the sky when you make Waterfront Park your destination for 4th of July fireworks. In addition to views of several explosive performances, visitors to the park will enjoy recreational activities like hands-on craft activities, interactive lawn games, a Hawk Talk live raptor show, a nature discovery table, food trucks and more.

July 18, 5 p.m. | Yoga on the Waterfront

Take a deep breath and treat yourself to yoga on the bay. This all-levels outdoor class includes a playful Vinyasa flow, restorative stretches and a savasana with singing bowls. Leave the class more connected to your body, breath and mind. Meet on Civic Green 4 and bring your own mat, towel and water.

July 24, 9 a.m. | Chess with a Ranger

Game on! Visit our new chess tables for a fun game of chess. Supervising Park Ranger Sam will be there to guide and challenge you while you test and fine-tune your chess skill set. Players of all levels are invited to participate, and to learn more about summer offerings at this seaside destination.

July 31, 6 p.m. | Hullabaloo Concert

All ages will get a kick out of this special evening of singing and dancing at Waterfront Park in this free-range, organic folk concert featuring a foot-stomping, wing-flapping celebration of song. It's designed for kids but entertains all – and you can't beat the concert location.

ABOUT THE PARK

Welcoming residents and visitors alike, Waterfront Park is the most significant recreational open space area in downtown San Diego. The existing historic landscape and landmark County building form the park's center, while an interactive splash fountain extends from the building and into the park defining a large civic green. Kids enjoy having a splash, while cooling off on warm days. The park also features large works of art, a vibrant children's play zone, and is host to dozens of special events, private events and Summer Movies in the Park showings, every year.
