- IV. Park and Recreation Staff reports:
  - a. Kelly:
    - i. We went over the budget; we are 83% spent.
    - ii. Floors in gym have been repaired.
    - iii. Mold in Community center has been taken care of.
    - iv. We are on track to exceed our revenue goal.
    - v. We had a car fire at Sweetwater Lane Park, Joe assisted in the cleanup, however the car is still on the property we are working on getting it towed.
    - vi. We are adding two new "Free Little Libraries" at Ildica and Eucalyptus parks, should be placed this summer.
    - vii. Calavo Park is still on track to open in the Fall.
