## ● SURVEY


An online survey was shared with the community **June 26 to July 14** to collect feedback on the schematic design and proposed programs.



- Adequate nighttime lighting, clear sightlines, and security cameras are recommended to support secured site

- The natural light and ventilation features create an inviting space
- The space should be low maintenance and user friendly to the public.
