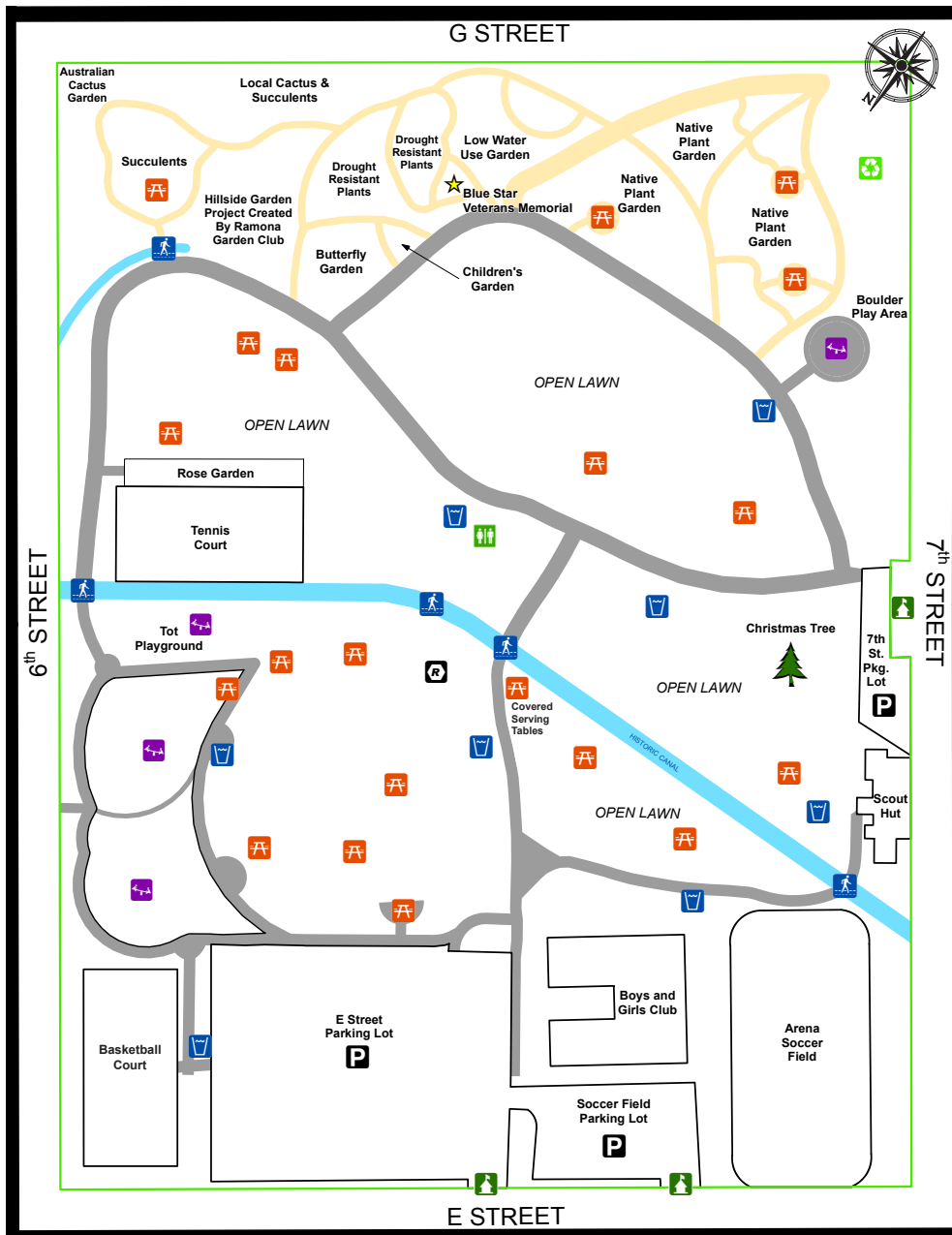

Collier County Park is the oldest park in San Diego County. It was donated to Ramona in 1913 by David C. Collier, a lawyer and real estate developer. The 8-acre community park has a shaded picnic area, soccer arena and plenty of recreational options for families to enjoy. Recently, a new basketball court and playground equipment were installed. Alcoholic drinks are not allowed at this park.

## David C. Collier

(1871-1934), a lawyer, real estate developer, and civic leader, played an important part in the growth and development of early San Diego.

Collier donated the land that later would become Collier County Park, according to a 1914 newspaper article which says his intentions were to “make it a playground for the people of today as well as generations to come.”

**DIRECTIONS:** Take Highway 67 to Ramona. Turn right on 7th Street, then left on E Street. The park is on the corner of 7th and E Street.
