



GENERAL INFORMATION

Lake Morena County Park is located at 2550 Lake Morena Drive, Campo, CA 91906. The lake is open from **6:00 am to 7:30 pm**. **All boats must be off the lake by 7:00 pm.**

- The current water temperature is 74 degrees.
- Live bait-fish and crayfish are prohibited.
- **CALIFORNIA STATE FISHING LICENSE IS REQUIRED!**

NEWS AND EVENTS

- **Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the most recent public health order, Lake Morena's youth group campsite, playground, indoor pavilion, and BBQ grills remain closed.**
- **Campground and cabins are open at full capacity!**
- **Due to additional disinfecting procedures, only half of the rental boats are being made available on a first come first serve basis each day.**
- **Lake level remains at its highest in more than a decade, boat ramp is open to launch!**
 - All vessels must pass a Quagga Mussel Inspection (clean, drained, and dry) prior to launch.
 - An \$8 launch fee is required for all private vessels.

BEST SPOTS

CATFISH	Geezer Cove, T-Dock, Bass Cove
TROUT	Horseshoe cove, Paradise Cove, Pumphouse Cove
BASS	Paradise Cove, Geezer Cove, North shoreline
PANFISH/CARP	Horseshoe Cove, Geezer Gove (Panfish) + Geezer Cove or T-Dock (Carp)

BEST LURES/BAITS

CATFISH	Mackerel, Bonito, Night Crawlers, Chicken Liver
TROUT	Powerbait, Night Crawlers, Mini Jigs, Kastmasters
BASS	Swimbait, Plastics, crankbaits, Jigs
PANFISH/CARP	Mealworms & Night Crawlers (Panfish) / Dough Balls, Corn (Carp)

CATCH HIGHLIGHTS

CATFISH	Catfish caught mostly on mackerel and chicken liver around rock outcroppings across from docks
TROUT	With water temperatures up, Trout season has come to a close. No recent catches to report.
BASS	Bass are biting consistently right now, mostly closer in away from the dam.
PANFISH/CARP	Crappie and Bluegill are being caught on occasion, while Carp can still be caught throughout the lake.
