County Supervisor Nora Vargas and the County of San Diego Department of Parks and Recreation will conduct a ribbon-cutting ceremony to open a new campground in Tijuana River Valley Regional Park. This unique camping destination is now the southwestern-most campground in the continental U.S.

The 79-acre campground offers breathtaking views of the valley, with connections to over 20 miles of trails enjoyed by hikers, bikers and equestrians. It contains a nature education center, 51 primitive campsites and is also the first County campground to offer yurts – covered camping spaces with doors, windows, bed frames and room for six to 10 people.

After the Grand Opening, join Ranger Dale for a special walk and talk on river valley wildlife, discover flora, fauna, birds and learn about the area's local history and farm culture.

Greg Cox Bike Park is the first bike skills area in Otay Valley Regional Park. Spanning 3.2 acres, it includes beginner and intermediate bike trails, beginner's zone, a jump line and the largest modular pump track in the state of California!

We're celebrating its grand opening with a ribbon cutting event, featuring presentations by County Supervisor Nora Vargas, Chula Vista Mayor Mary Casillas Salas and others.

Easy to access from nearby neighborhoods, roads and existing trails, the park is designed for riders of all ages and skill levels.

There's no cost to visit – join us for this special event, and every day, between the hours of 8 a.m. and dusk.
