The County of San Diego Department of Parks and Recreation is researching opportunities for recreational Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) facilities in the region. This is following an action by the County Board of Supervisors in 2021 to identify feasible locations for OHV sites to meet the demand of OHV owners and users, and to prevent unauthorized use on public lands.

This is the second meeting to discuss OHV opportunities and to collect community feedback. Staff will be sharing information on the OHV Feasibility Study process, as well as providing details on public involvement.

After the informational presentation, program staff will host a question-and-answer session. Participation is encouraged!
