Nestled just a short distance from the Pacific Ocean in Del Mar, San Dieguito County Park offers an easy loop trail, with lookout platforms, suspension bridges, and hillside ladders open for hikers to explore.

Meet at the park 'n' ride off Manchester to take this loop trail on an easy to moderate hike around the San Elijo Lagoon and through Annie's Canyon. It's a great gravel trail for birdwatching and exploring.

Martha's Grove Loop Trail is a moderately challenging route with great views of Sycamore Canyon. The trail is rocky in some areas and muddy in a few places where you'll have to cross a little stream.
