ABOUT THE MEETING

Tijuana River Valley Regional Park encompasses more than 1,800 acres of diverse, coastal habitat linked by an extensive 22.5-mile trail system. The County of San Diego Department of Parks and Recreation is working on a project to improve some of the Park's north-south trail connections, such as adding bridges or other structures, to minimize seasonal closures.

The Coastal Trail Feasibility Study analyzed improvements to multi-use trails that could make it easier to cross over the Tijuana River in four areas. Attend this virtual public meeting to learn about the Feasibility Study, ask questions, and share your feedback on project priorities.
