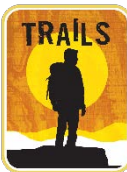
OVERVIEW MAP

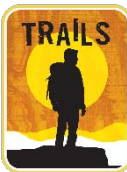
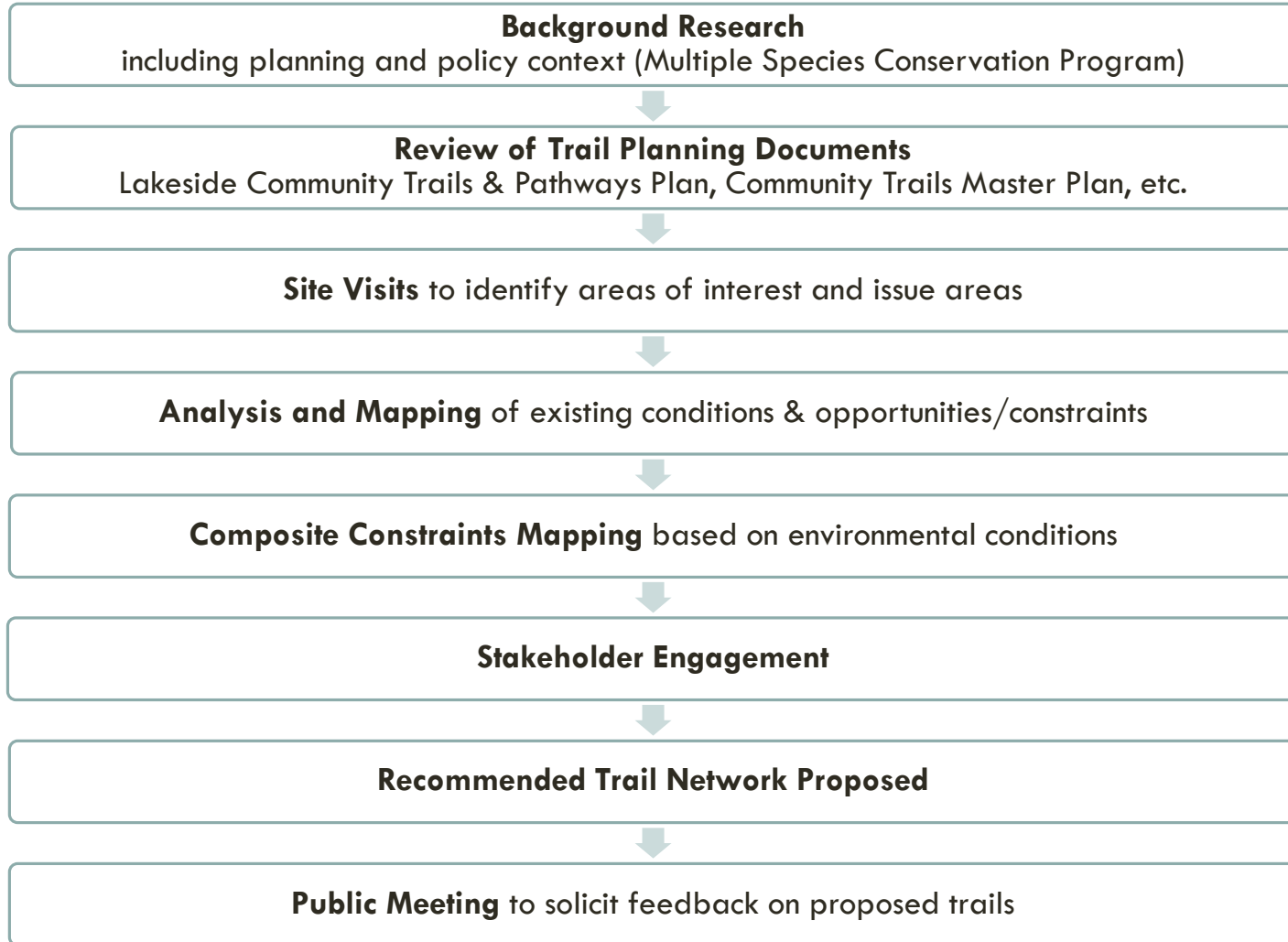
PRIMARY GOALS

- Provide recreational appeal while conserving natural resources and educating visitors

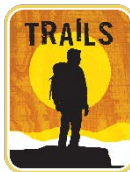

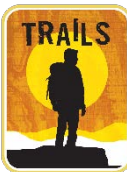
